



QUICK START GUIDE

Please read carefully, and follow the steps below before any interaction with the PC to ensure your system is properly prepared for operation.

Step 1 Unboxing.

Please follow the instructions below to ensure you **don't damage** your system's box. **Keep your box and packaging.**



Open the flaps on the top side of the box by cutting the duct tape securing it.



Rest the box on the floor and pull the system out slowly, allowing it to slide on the floor.

Step 2 Removal of internal packaging material.

Some systems may include protective packaging that **must be removed** before turning on the computer.



Open the side panel of the case and **remove** all internal packaging before use. Failure to do so may **damage** your components.

Step 3 Connecting your display.

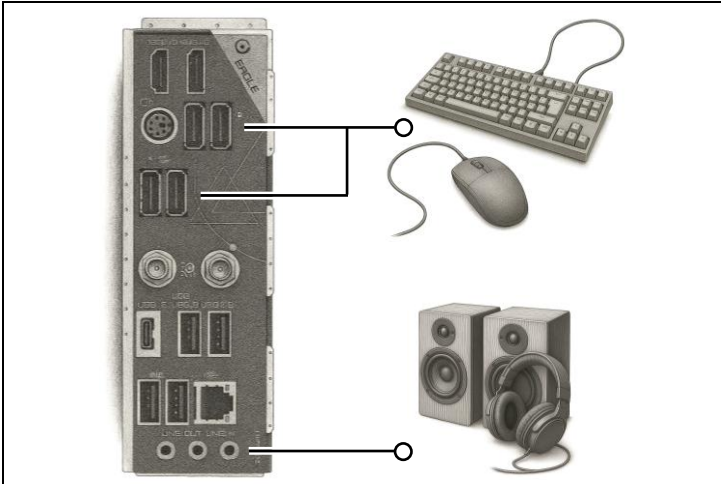
Refer to the figure below to identify which connector you should be using in order to connect your monitor.



Connect your display to the ports highlighted in **red**. If your system doesn't have these connectors, use the ports in **yellow**.

Step 4 Connecting your peripherals.

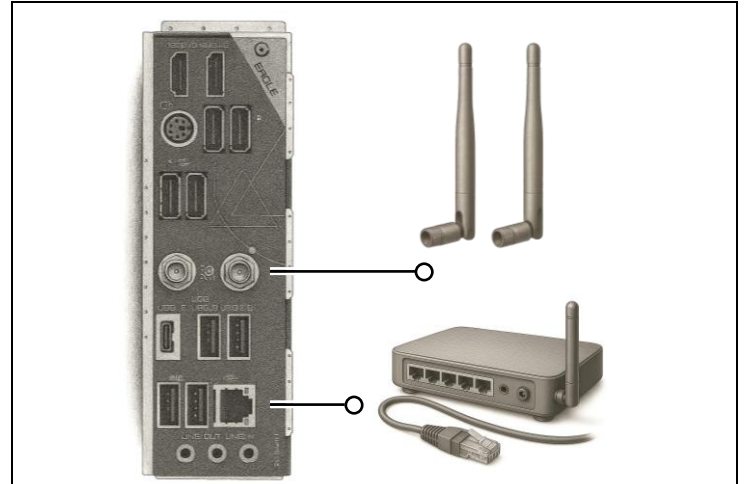
Refer to the figure below to connect your peripherals such as mouse, keyboard, speakers and headset.



When in doubt, please refer to the manufacturer's manual when connecting your peripherals.

Step 5 Setting up internet access.

If your system has a WiFi card, make sure your WiFi aerials are screwed onto the back of the WiFi card during set up.



Aerials are screwed onto the gold-coloured connectors indicated above. In alternative, please use an **ethernet cable**.

Step 6 Powering on your system.

Use the provided power cord. Connect one end to your system's power supply and the other end to a wall outlet.



Connect the power cable to the power supply and to a wall socket. **Flick** the power supply switch to the ON (I) position.



Power on your system using the front power button.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Why did my system come with extra parts and cables? Do I need them to use my computer?

The extra parts and cables are provided to you in the event that you want to add more hardware or features to your computer in the future. They DO NOT need to be installed before using the computer.

My system is booting up and I can hear it but I don't see anything on the monitor.

Make sure that your display is connected to a HDMI or DP port on the graphics card. **Please refer to Step 3 of the Quick Start Guide** sent to you via email. Open the glass-side panel of your system and check for loose cables and components. Although it is rare, components may have moved during transit. Please report any issues immediately.

My system is not connecting to the internet.

Please double-check your order invoice to ensure your system comes with a wireless card. If a wireless card has been selected, please make sure you have connected the aerials which were sent to you. These are simply screwed onto the gold connectors at the back of your PC. If your system doesn't come with a wireless card, you can connect to the internet using an ethernet cable. **Please refer to step 5 of the Quick Start Guide** sent to you via email.

The power button of my PC is not responding and the PC doesn't turn on.

Make sure that the power cable is connected to the power supply and to a wall socket. Flick the power supply switch to the ON (I) position before pressing the power button. **Please refer to Step 6 of the Quick Start Guide** sent to you via email.

Notes (read carefully)

We strongly recommend to store the box and packaging shipped with your system. These guarantee the best protection in case of returns/collections, repairs or upgrades. Note that in case of returns/collections, we won't be responsible for any damage caused by improper packaging of the system. Eventual repairs as a result of damage due to improper packaging will be charged.

All internal packaging must be removed from the inside of the case before using the computer. Failure to do so may result in permanent damage to the electrical components.
